Alberta Dance Alliance is a provincial service organization that exists to foster and promote the appreciation and practice of dance in Alberta.



EDUCATION & SERVICES

- Provides support for professional development through consultation in grant research/preparation/editing, administration/business/production management, and career preparation.
- Support through the Community Workshop Series and workshops by request.
Available to organizations hosting workshops in technique, professional development, and industry awareness.
- Offers Stepping Out – a program for career planning in public schools/studios for dance students.
- Offers an online job board employment registry for dancers, choreographers, production and support personnel.
- Provides current, up-to-date information through DanceLines, a biweekly electronic newsletter.
- Produces the DanceLink calendar, an annual publication featuring events and grant deadlines.
- Co-hosts *on the MOVE* and *keep on MOVING* the Dancer Transition Resource Centre (DTRC). Conferences for graduating dance students and dance professionals.
- Offers a link between experts in the field of marketing and publicity.
- Hosts an archival website, 100 Feet of Dance (Diaries of Dance in Alberta).
- Meeting rooms available upon request.

ADVOCACY

- Advocates and is a strong active voice with other municipal, provincial, and federal arts/dance service organizations for increased support to arts/dance in the public and private sector.
- Advocates for the status of artists' issues, supports Canadian Alliance of Dance Artists (CADA) Basic Dance Agreement.

- Advocates for dance in education and is an active voice for dance in the Albertan and Canadian cultural and human resources sectors.
- ADA is a member of Alberta Partners for Arts and Culture (APAC), a coalition of Alberta's eight Provincial Arts Service Organizations (PASO) and four Cultural Industry Associations (CIA).
- Advocates the support of the national service organization Canadian Dance Assembly (CDA).
- Participates in Canadian dance research and sharing of community information.

AWARENESS

- Provides financial aid for Community Workshop Series and Community Mini-Conferences.
- Produces FEATS – Festival of Dance to celebrate the Alberta dance community and to provide an opportunity for creation, presentation, and performance.
- Facilitates all regions in Alberta with their celebrations of International Dance Day on April 29, and is a direct link to the World International Dance Day activities.
